(I) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

General: Based on observation, the surveyor observed a large Little Tikes climbing structure with slide inside the Twos Classroom. The climbing structure is too large for the classroom, creating a safety risk as one (1) child was observed napping underneath the climbing structure's slide. The climbing structure is close to the classroom walls. This creates a safety concern as a child could fall from the climbing structure into a wall.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) The surveyor observed several areas where food was spilled on the floor of the School Age Classroom.
- (2.) Chocolate milk was observed spilled in the hallway of the child care center.
- (3.) The Toddler Classroom had a large pile of food on top of the high chair's tabletop.

Staff reported they had not had a chance to throw the food away since the children ate lunch although the children were already laying down for nap when the surveyor arrived to the child care center.

640 - Toilet Room Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (2) A toilet room shall:
- (a) 1. Be provided for each gender; or
- 2. A plan shall be implemented to use the same toilet room at separate times;
- (b) Have a supply of toilet paper; and
- (c) Be cleaned and disinfected daily.

Findings:

645 - Sink

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) The sink located in the Girls' Restroom contained brown stains inside the sink bowl; therefore, the restroom was not clean.
- (2.) The sink located in the Boys' Restroom contained brown stains and dirty paper towels inside the sink bowl; therefore, the restroom was not clean.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

2\ A sink shall bar

- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the hand-washing sink located in the Girls' Restroom was not equipped with cold water. The cold-water knob turns on the sink; however, no water comes out of the faucet. Staff was not aware of the issue.

650 - Toilet Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and
- (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the toilet located in the Boys' Restroom contained light brown grime around the bracket that holds the seat onto the toilet; therefore, the toilet was not in a clean condition.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a substance yellow in color spilled throughout the floor in the kitchen; therefore, the kitchen was not clean.

1015 - Food Service Permit

(2) A child-care center required to have a food service permit shall be in compliance with 902 KAR 45:005 and this administrative regulation.

Findings:

General: Based on interview, the surveyor requested to review the child care center's food service permit. Staff at the child care center were unable to present a current food service permit, stating staff had renewed the permit; however, a copy of the permit had not been provided to the center.

1040 - Kitchen Equipment Clean and Sanitary

- (3.) A child's (DOE: 2/22/18) file contained an immunization that was no longer current as of 6/21/18.
- (4.) A child's (DOE: 9/9/2020) file did not contain an immunization certificate.
- (5.) A child's (DOE: 10/15/2020) file did not contain an immunization certificate.
- (6.) A child's (DOE: 10/13/19) file did not contain an immunization certificate.
- (7.) A child's (DOE: 12/1/10) file contained an immunization certificate that was no longer current as of 12/4/2020.
- (8.) A child's (DOE: 8/14/2020) file contained an immunization certificate that was no longer current as of 8/31/2020.
