General: Based on review of documentation, a caregiver hired on 8/29/19, had TB documentation on file that was dated 8/15/19. A caregiver hired on 1/4/10, had TB documentation on file that was dated 12/23/19. Two (2) caregivers hired on 2/5/20 and 12/30/15, each had TB documentation on file that was dated 12/27/19. A caregiver hired on 11/25/16, had TB documentation on file that was dated 12/20/19.

## 410 - CPR/First Aid Coverage

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(3) For a child-care center licensed for infant, toddler, or preschool-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:

(a) Infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and

(b) Infant and child first aid.

(4) For a child-care center licensed for school-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:

(a) Adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and

(b) First aid.

(5) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and first aid training shall be in addition to the fifteen (15) clock hours requirement in subsection (16) of this section.

General: Based on review of documentation, no caregiver was certified in first aid and CPR during the hours of operation.

Findings: General: Based on review of documentation, two (2) caregivers hired on 2/24/21 and 2/5/20, were not trained in first aid and CPR. 435 - Training **Not In Compliance** 922 KAR 2:090. (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following: (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program; (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $^{\prime\prime}\!$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
