Review of ECE-TRIS training report verified the provider did not complete nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved training. Interview with the provider revealed she did not complete nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved training.

- (a) At least monthly; and
- (b) Documented.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the family child care home failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of presented documentation revealed the provider did not have documentation of monthly fire drills. Interview with the provider revealed she had conducted the fire drills; however, she was not able to locate the documentation at the time of the survey.

630 - Tornado Drill Requirements

- (20) An earthquake drill and a tornado drill shall be conducted during hours of operation:
- (a) At least quarterly; and
- (b) Documented.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the family child care home failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of presented documentation revealed the provider did not have documentation of earthquake drills and tornado drills conducted quarterly. Interview with the provider revealed she had conducted the earthquake drills and tornado drills quarterly; however, she was not able to locate the documentation of the conducted drills at the time of the survey.

640 - Earthquake Drills Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:100 - Section 18. Records.

- (5) A certified family child-care home provider shall maintain a written record of:
- (a) Quarterly practiced earthquake drills and tornado dills detailing the date, time, and participants in accordance with Section 11(20) of this administrative regulation;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the family child care home failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of presented documentation revealed there was not a written record of when earthquake drills and tornado drills were conducted detailing the date, time and participants. Interview with the provider revealed she had conducted the earthquake drills and tornado drills documenting in writing the date, time and participants; however, she was not able to locate the written record documenting the drills at the time of the survey.

645 - Fire Drills Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:100 - Section 18. Records.

- (5) A certified family child-care home provider shall maintain a written record of:
- (b) Monthly practiced fire drills detailing the date, time, and participants in accordance with Section 11(19) of this administrative regulation; and

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the family child care home failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of presented documentation revealed there was not a written record of when fire drills were conducted detailing the date, time and participants. Interview with the provider revealed she had conducted the fire drills documenting in writing the date, time and participants; however, she was not able to locate the written record documenting the drills at the time of the survey.
