General: Based on Observation, it was found that there was no protective surface completely around the slide in the toddler classroom equal to the height of the equipment.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that an employee with a hire date of 08/22/2016 did not recieve a criminal records check until 09/08/2016. This instance is not in accordance with KRS 17.165 which requires that application for the criminal record of a probationary employee be made no later than the date probationary employment begins.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found through a review of thirteen (13) staff files that three (3) staff had no evidence of proof of education. The dates of hire for the staff were 08/15/2016, 08/22/2016 and 12/14/2016.

320 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that an employee with a hire date on 12/15/2015 had no evidence of being free of TB and an employee with a hire date of 01/25/2016 did not have any evidence of being free of TB.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that an employee with a hire date of 01/25/2016 and an employee with a hire date of 07/13/2016 did not have evidence of cabinet-approved orientation training within the first three (3) months of employment. Review of ECE-TRIS confirmed this. It was also found that through a review of thirteen (13) staff files, four (4) staff files did not have evidence of the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. The dates of hire for the staff were 12/15/2015 for three (3) staff and 07/14/2014 for one (1) staff. Review of ECE-TRIS confirmed this.
