General: Based on Review of Documentation, staff hired on 09/26/17 and 09/14/17 did not have tuberculosis skin test results prior to their employment. Their results were read on 12/11/17 and 12/13/17.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, staff hired on 08/15/16 did not have the required pediatric abusive head trauma class on file. Staff hired on 12/15/15 and 08/28/10 did not renew the pediatric abusive head trauma class that is required every five (5) years. This information was verified through ECE-TRIS.
