- (2) A child care staff member hired on or after April 1, 2018, shall:
- (a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or
- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation; and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A staff hired on 1/13/2021, did not have written evidence of completing the KARES background check. The staff member's file contained a completed child abuse/neglect and criminal records check. The staff member was not working during the renewal survey. The KARES system was reviewed.

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A staff hired on 10/10/2021, did not have proof of education on file.

## 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. A staff member hired on 7/26/2021, did not completed the required Orientation. This staff member has been employed for more than three months.
- 2. A staff member hired on 8/15/2021, did not complete the required Orientation. This staff member has been employed for more than three months.

The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed and confirmed these findings.

General: Based on observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. The Preschool Room (the L-shaped room) contained a rectangular hole in the ceiling. The staff in charge indicated that the vent cover was not replaced when the HVAC was worked on recently

General: Based on observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. The side playground contained an air-conditioning condensing unit that was unprotected. The staff in charge indicated that the unit was recently replaced, and the fencing had not yet been put back up around the unit. The wooden fencing was observed on the ground next to the unit.

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The Two-Year-Old Room contained a small refrigerator with milk inside it. The refrigerator did not contain a thermometer; therefore, the temperature could not be determined.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The facility did not have the statement of deficiency and plan of correction posted from the 9/21/2021 renewal survey.
