General: Based on Review of Documentation, the Fire Marshal's inspection report indicated the center failed to meet requirements on 1/20/17. The report stated for the center to make necessary repairs to the fire alarm system to ensure proper operation.

- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
- (j) Assess each staff person's interaction with children in care and classroom performance through an annual written performance evaluation;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, two (2) caregivers hired on 2/1/16 and 1/27/16, did not have an evaluation on file.

275 - Caregiver Alone

922 KAR 2:110. Section 4. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
- (n) Assure that a person acting as a caregiver of a child in care shall not be left alone with a child, if the licensee has not received the results of the background checks as described in Section 3(1)(e)6 of this administrative regulation;

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, a caregiver hired on 12/27/16, was alone with nine (9) children in the PreK room. Interview with the director indicated the caregiver had been alone since 8:00 a.m. on 04/27/17 and for the past three (3) weeks in the PreK room. The caregiver had no Kentucky criminal records check and no Illinois criminal records check on file.

- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;

- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and

- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver was rehired on 11/8/16, but there was no documentation of a current processed child abuse/neglect check and criminal records check on file. Interview with director determined the checks were not submitted.

A caregiver hired on 12/27/16, had no Kentucky criminal records check and no Illinois criminal records check on file. This caregiver was alone with nine (9) children in the PreK room. Interview with the director indicated the caregiver had supervised children alone since 8:00 a.m. on 04/27/17 and for the past three (3) weeks in the PreK room.

320 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
 - 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver hired on 1/27/16, had TB documentation on file dated 4/1/15.

General: Based on Observation, a light/ventilation fixture was uncovered and had no shatterproof bulb in the restroom located between the two-year-olds' room and toddler room #2.

(3) A sink shall be:

- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;

670 - Medication

General: Based on Observation, the hot water temperature was eighty-five (85) degrees Fahrenheit in the restroom located between the preschool room and preK room.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, a bottle of Equate Children's Multi-Symptom Cold was not labeled in the medicine box located in the preschool room. Two (2) bottles of Coppertone Water Babies and one (1) bottle of Aveeno Baby Eczema Therapy Moisturizing Cream were on top of a four (4) drawer file cabinet located in the preschool room. Each bottle indicated it had active ingredients.

General: Based on Observation, fabric weed block was above the rubber mulch in several areas of the younger children's outdoor play area. The longest area was approximately six (6) feet long. Also, approximately four (4) feet of fabric weed block fabric was above the pea gravel in the older children's outdoor play area.

General: Based on Observation, a Step Two double slide was not anchored to the ground in the older children's outdoor play area.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, two (2) swings had rust on the chain links in the younger children's outdoor play area. There were dark spots on a brown alphabet area rug located in the preschool room. Three (3) Graco Highchairs and one (1) Fisher Price Highchair were missing safety restraint straps in toddler room #1. Also, one (1) blue highchair had no safety restraint straps in the infants' room.

(2) A child-care center required to have a food service permit shall be in compliance with 902 KAR 45:005 and this administrative regulation.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, lunch was catered by Paducah Middle School and the posted caterer's food service permit was dated 12/31/16. Also, documentation of the agreement between the center and the caterer did not indicate which meals would be catered. Interview with a staff member indicated breakfast and snacks were prepared by the center and lunch was prepared by the caterer.

935 - Refrigerator **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 8. Kitchen Requirements.

- (4) A cold-storage facility used for storage of perishable food in a nonfrozen state shall:
- (a) Have an indicating thermometer or other appropriate temperature measuring device;
- (b) Be in a safe environment for preservation; and
- (c) Be forty (40) degrees Fahrenheit or below.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, there was no thermometer in a small refrigerator located in the toddler #2 room.

940 - Frozen Food **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 8. Kitchen Requirements.

- (5) Frozen food shall be:
- (a) Kept at a temperature of zero degrees Fahrenheit or below; and
- (b) Thawed:
- 1. At refrigerator temperatures;
- 2. Under cool, potable running water;
- 3. As part of the cooking process; or
- 4. By another method in accordance with the Department of Public Health's food safety standards and permits, established in KRS Chapter

217.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, there was no thermometer in the small refrigerator freezer located in toddler room #2.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a child enrolled on 8/28/16, had no immunization certificate on file.

- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a child enrolled on 12/15/15, did not have contact information for a physician.
