Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff hired on 02/24/16, and a staff hired on 04/12/16, did not have an annual written performance evaluation on file.

265 - Health, Safety, Comfort Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 4. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
- (I) Provide for the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, two (2) electrical outlets were not covered on an electrical strip on the floor of the infants' room.

275 - Caregiver Alone **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:110. Section 4. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
- (n) Assure that a person acting as a caregiver of a child in care shall not be left alone with a child, if the licensee has not received the results of the background checks as described in Section 3(1)(e)6 of this administrative regulation;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and observation, a staff hired on 10/07/16, did not have an out-of-state criminal records check on file from Arkansas, which was a previous state of residence, and a staff, hired on 03/06/17, did not have a criminal records check on file from Kentucky and from two (2) previous states of residences, Tennessee and Texas. In addition, both staff members, together, supervised eight (8) children in the two and three-year-olds' room.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and observation, a staff hired on 10/07/16, did not have a criminal records check on file from Arkansas, which was a previous state of residence, and a staff hired on 03/06/17, did not have a criminal records check on file from Kentucky and from two (2) previous states of residences, Tennessee and Texas. In addition, both staff members were left alone and supervised eight (8) children in the two and three-year-olds' room.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff hired on 01/09/17, a staff hired on 10/07/16, and a staff hired on 03/07/17, did not have education verification on file.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff hired on 01/09/17, had TB documentation on file dated 09/30/14. A staff hired on 03/06/17, did not have TB documentation on

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff hired on 10/07/16, a staff hired on 11/14/16, and two (2) staffs, hired on 01/09/17, did not complete six (6) hours of cabinet approved orientation training. A staff hired on 04/12/16, completed seven and a half (7 1/2) hours of cabinet approved training during the first year of employment.

General: Based on Observation and interview, an infant slept in a swing for approximately forty-five (45) minutes in the infants room. The infant did not have an alternative sleep waiver signed by the infant's physician on file.

435 - Bedding/Toys in Crib

922 KAR 2:120. Section 6. Sleeping and Napping Requirements.

- (3) Rest time shall include adequate space specified by the child's age as follows:
- (a) For an infant:
- 3. No loose bedding; and
- 4. No toys or other items except the infant's pacifier;

General: Based on Observation, an infant slept in a crib with loose bedding in the infants' room.

- (7) Except in accordance with subsection (8) of this section, the following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:
- (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;
- (b) Knives and sharp objects;
- (c) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids;
- (d) Plastic bags;
- (e) Litter and rubbish;
- (f) Bar soap; and
- (g) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, a caregiver's bag hung on a hook on the wall and a caregiver's coat hung on a chair in the two and three-year-olds' room. A bottle filled with soapy water and a bottle filled with bleach water were stored on the side of the diapering station in the toddlers' restroom. A wadded up plastic bag was stored in a fabric container in the bottom of the diapering station in the infants' room. All of these items were accessible to children.

585 - Sink Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the changing table in the infants' room was approximately twenty-five (25) feet away from the hand-washing sink located in the restroom down the hall.

General: Based on Observation, three (3) children did not wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival to the center.

- (a) Stored in a separate and locked place, out of the reach of a child;
- (b) Kept in the original bottle; and

- (7) Medication shall not be given to a child if the expiration date on the bottle has passed.

Findings

General: Based on Observation, a small tube of clotrimazole was stored unlocked on a rack above the toilet in the toddlers' restroom. Two (2), four (4) ounce tubes of Desitin were stored in an unlocked cabinet on the wall in the toddlers' room.
