General: Based on interview, a caregiver hired 11/14/16, harshly snatched a two-year-old child by her right arm. The child's foot knocked over a chair. The child's feet did not touch the ground, while the caregiver carried and slung the child in the corner. The child stood facing the wall with her hands on the wall for time out in the two-year-old room on 10/15/18. The caregiver hired 11/14/16, statement and interview revealed the video footage looked as if the caregiver was rough; therefore, the director did not provide for the safety and comfort of this child. The center policy revealed time out was used for the form of discipline.
