General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a staff member hired 08/02/21, did not have TB documentation on file. A staff member hired 09/02/19, had TB documentation on file that was dated 12/30/19.

415 - CPR/First Aid Required Training

(8) Each center shall ensure that every staff member has received training on first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, four (4) staff members hired on 09/27/16, 09/02/19, 08/02/21, and 08/01/20, did not complete first aid/CPR training.

435 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a staff member hired 09/27/16, did not complete any hours of training during a subsequent year of employment. A staff member hired 09/27/16, completed eight (8) hours of training during a subsequent year of employment. A staff member hired 08/01/20, completed ten and one-quarter (10 ½) hours of training during a subsequent year of employment.

A staff member hired 09/27/16, completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training on 10/12/15. A staff member hired 02/24/16, completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training on 02/26/16. A staff member hired 08/01/20 completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training on 01/07/15. A staff member hired 09/02/19, completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training on 01/27/17. Each staff did not complete the Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training again within five (5) years.

Two (2) staff members hired 11/15/21, and 08/02/21, did not complete six (6) hours of orientation training within the first three (3) months of employment.

General: Based on observation and interview, a staff member's black coat hung on the back of an adult chair and was accessible to children in the two-year-olds' room.

625 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings

General: Based on observation and interview, a two (2) inch by five (5) inch hole was in the drywall behind the entrance door of the restroom that was located across from the preschool classroom.
