922 KAR 2:110. Section 4. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.
(1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
(j) Assess each staff person's interaction with children in care and classroom performance through an annual written performance evaluation;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, two (2) caregivers, hired on 7/5/16 and 7/12/16, did not have a written performance evaluation on file.

340 - Training **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.
(14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, caregiver hired 7/11/16, completed six (6) hours of orientation on 6/17/17, caregiver hired 11/7/16, completed six (6) hours of orientation on 8/13/17, caregivers hired on 3/3/17 and 3/11/17, completed six (6) hours of orientation training on 6/17/17. These caregivers did not complete orientation training within the first three (3) months of their employment.

- (4) The child-care center shall provide a daily planned program:**
 - (a) Posted in writing in a conspicuous location with each age group and followed;**
 - (b) Of activities that are individualized and developmentally appropriate for each child served;**
 - (c) That provides experience to promote the individual child's physical, emotional, social, and intellectual growth and well-being; and**
 - (d) That offers a variety of creative activities including the following:**
 - 1. Art;**
 - 2. Music;**
 - 3. Dramatic play;**
 - 4. Stories and books;**
 - 5. Science;**
 - 6. Block building;**
 - 7. Tactile activity;**
 - 8. Culture;**
 - 9. Indoor or outdoor play in which a child makes use of both small and large muscles;**
 - 10. A balance of active and quiet play, including group and individual activity;**
 - 11. An opportunity for a child to:**
 - a. Have some free choice of activities;**
 - b. If desired, play apart from the group at times;**

General: Based on Observation, the program of activities was not developed and posted in the infants' room, the one year olds' room and in the two-year-olds' room.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:**
 - (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;**
 - (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;**
 - (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;**
 - (d) Equipped with liquid soap;**
 - (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;**
 - (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and**
 - (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.**

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the hot water temperature registered 70 degrees Fahrenheit at the handwashing sink in the ten-month-olds' room and the three-year-olds' room.

 - (b) Kept in the original bottle; and**
 - (c) Properly labeled.**
- (7) Medication shall not be given to a child if the expiration date on the bottle has passed.**

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, a tube of Nystatin was stored on a sink in a plastic container in the two-year-olds' room.

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:**
 - (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;**
 - (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;**
 - (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and**
 - (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.**

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the freezer in the ten month olds' room and the two-year-olds' room had an accumulation of ice.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a child enrolled on 12/5/16, immunization certificate was dated 9/17/17.

(1) A child-care center shall maintain:
(b) A written record for each child:
1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;
2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and
3. To contain:
a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
(i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
(ii) Family physician; and
(iii) Preferred hospital;
c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
(i) Allergies;
(ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
(iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving or impacting the child;
f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a child enrolled 12/5/16, enrollment information did not include the name of the preferred hospital.

(f) A written annual plan for child-care staff professional development;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, two (2) caregivers, each hired on 7/5/16, and caregivers hired on 7/12/16, 11/17/16, 2/20/17, 7/11/16, 3/3/17, and 3/11/17, did not have a written plan for annual professional development.

1145 - Earthquake/Tornado Drills

(b) Documented.

Findings:

General: Based on Interview, quarterly earthquake and tornado drills were not conducted during the 3rd quarter of 2016 and the 1st and 2nd quarters of 2017.
