- (e) Amended in writing with any substitutions on the day the meal is served.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. At the time of the survey it was found that a menu listing afternoon snack was posted; however, there was no menu listing what is served for breakfast and lunch.

The staff person in charge stated that breakfast and lunch are provided by the school cafeteria.

- 1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;
- 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and
- 3. To contain:
- a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
- b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies;
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the following was found:

- 1. The facility failed to obtain the following information for one child enrolled at the facility: information for the family's preferred hospital, authorization for emergency medical care, physician contact information, and information regarding who was allowed to pick up the child. The staff person in charge stated that she is still waiting on one of the enrollment packet forms to be turned in by the child's parents.
- 2. One child currently enrolled at the facility did not have enrollment paperwork on file; therefore, none of the required information had been obtained.

- (h) A written record of quarterly practiced earthquake drills and tornado drills detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;
- (i) A written record of practiced fire drills conducted monthly detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A review of the 2020 fire drill log found that a drill was not conducted during the month of November; therefore, drills are not conducted monthly.
