Findings:	
<p>General: Based on observation and interview, the child-care center failed to meet this regulation. The surveyor entered the child-care center at approximately 12:18 p.m. and observed six (6) water stained ceiling tiles. Additionally, the surveyor observed a small area of black residue on the wall directly under one ceiling tile located in the Nursery.</p> <p>Staff stated that on Monday, July 22, 2019, they noticed that there was water dripping from a ceiling tile located in the preschool classroom, but it soon stopped. Staff stated that it was possible that the water dripping from the ceiling tile was a result of a storm that had come through the area the night before. The director stated that the owner immediately notified the property manager about the water stained ceiling tiles.</p> <p>The director stated on Thursday evening, July 25, 2019 she noticed an area of black residue on the wall directly under a water stained ceiling tile located in the nursery. She stated she was unsure if the black residue was mold.</p> <p>The director and infant staff stated a toddler enrolled in the Nursery has been breaking out in hives since he enrolled in March and they were concerned that it could be due to possible mold inside of the building.</p> <p>The child's mother stated her child has had hives since he enrolled in the child-care center. She stated she recently had her child tested to determine what he is allergic to and found that he is allergic to a type of mold that occurs outside.</p> <p>It is important to note the child-care center voluntarily closed early on July 26, 2019 due to the suspicions of mold in the child-care center.</p>
