Provider/Representative

General: Based on Interview and review of documentation, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. Interviews and documentation revealed that a six (6) year old male child was confined to a bare room as a result of inappropriate behavior, and other times physically restrained for up to ten (10) minutes without documentation revealing that the child posed a threat to himself or other children in his presence.
