General: Based on observation and interview, a program of activities was not developed and posted in the school age classroom.

- (7) The following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:
- (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;
- (b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and
- (c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, three (3) spray bottles of disinfectant were stored on the changing table in the infants' room. In addition, a bottle of Natural Insect Repellent and a bottle Baby Bum Sunscreen spray were stored on the bottom shelf of an unlocked changing table in the two-year-olds' room. All of these items were accessible to children and the warning label for each stated, "Keep out of reach of children."

- (4) A child shall:
- (a) Be helped with personal care and cleanliness based upon his or her developmental skills;
- (b) Except as established in paragraph (c) of this subsection, wash his or her hands with liquid soap and warm running water:
- 1. a. Upon arrival at the center; or
- b. Within thirty (30) minutes of arrival for school-age children;
- 2. Before and after eating or handling food;
- 3. After toileting or diaper change;
- 4. After handling animals;
- 5. After touching an item or an area of the body soiled with body fluids or wastes; and
- 6. After outdoor or indoor play time; and
- (c) Use hand sanitizer or hand-sanitizing wipes if liquid soap and warm running water are not available in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection. The child shall wash the child's hands as soon as practicable once liquid soap and warm running water are available.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, a child did not wash his hands with liquid soap and warm, running water after being diapered in the infants' room.
