Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to comply with staffing requirements. Observation in the One's classroom on 1/22/19 from 3:40pm until 3:50pm revealed one (1) staff member had supervisory authority over nine (9) one-year-old children for ten (10) minutes; therefore, the center exceeded minimum staff-to-child ratios during this time.

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulations. Observation of the Infant classroom on 1/15/19 revealed an infant lying on the floor drinking a bottle; therefore, the child was not held while being given a bottle.
