<p>922 KAR 2:120. Section 5. Infant and Toddler Play Requirements.</p> <p>(3) Except in accordance with subsection (4) of this section or Section 2(2)(c) of this administrative regulation, an infant or toddler under twenty-four (24) months of age shall not participate in an activity with an older child for no more than one (1) hour per day.</p> <p>(4) If a toddler is developmentally appropriate for a transition to a preschool age group, a toddler may participate in an activity with an older child for more than one (1) hour per day if:</p> <p>(a) Space for the toddler is available in the preschool-age group;</p> <p>(b) The staff-to-child ratios and group sizes are maintained based on the age of the youngest child;</p> <p>(c) The center has a procedure for listing a transitioning toddler on attendance records, including a specific day and time the toddler is with either age group; and</p> <p>(d) The child care center has obtained the signature and approval of the toddler's parent on the toddler's transition plan.</p>

General: Observation of the toddler room revealed there were children, ages ranging from one-year-old through four-years-old, that were observed combined together for longer than one (1) hour on the day of the inspection.
