General: Based on Interview and review of documentation, the center was providing care for preschool without approval. The staff person in charge stated that a group of seventeen (17) children were ages three (3) to five - years - old. The person in charge stated that the center was operating under a youth camp permit, however, youth camp permits are not valid for preschool care. Also, the center had previously indicated the center was clossed for the summer and did not inform DRCC of the intent to operate with a youth camp permit. The center is not licensed to provide care for preschool age children.
