(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the following was found:

1. Two staff members did not have evidence of completing 15-hours of annual early care and education training on file in the facility.

2. Five staff members did not have evidence of completing the required orientation training in the first three months of employment.

3. One staff member did not have evidence of completing the Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training within the first year of employment.
