General: Based on Observation, there was an eight (8) month old child asleep in a crib in the Infant classroom with a stuffed animal attached to his pacifier.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the posted classroom schedule in the Twos classroom indicated that nap time was from 11:45 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. This exceeds the two (2) hour rest time limit.
