690 - Sink

General: Based on observation and interview, a three (3) ounce bottle of Resinal Ointment and a 3.5 tube of Aquapher ointment were stored on a changing table in the infants' room. Each of these items were accessible to children and the warning label for each stated, "Keep out of reach of children."

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the hot water temperature registered eighty (80) degrees Fahrenheit at the restroom sink adjacent to the Pre-K II classroom.

General: Based on observation and interview, a "Do not Use" sign was posted on toilet that was inoperable in the Toddler II restroom.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the interior light was not working in the white Frigidaria refrigerator located in the kitchen. A multi-colored area rug was heavily stained in the infants' room.

General: Based on observation and interview, there was no temperature measuring device in the Haier refrigerator/freezer located in the kitchen. Therefore, it could not be determined that the freezer temperature was maintained at zero degrees Fahrenheit or below.
