The incident occurred sometime between 9:35 and 9:50 a.m. The staff person did not call the parent but sent a picture of the child's injury through the Kid's report application; however, the parent did not receive the picture or report due to issues with the application. The parent became aware of the injury when she picked up the child at 4:56 p.m. and was given an incident report. The parent reported when she picked up her child, his nose was swollen and bruised and both of his eyes were black. It should also be noted that there was no first aid administered to the child.
