1. The toilet seat in the One Year Old Room was loose. Staff stated that the seat would be repaired.
2. The toilet in the Two Year Old Room had urine on the seat. Staff reported that a child just used the restroom.

 - 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and**
 - 3. To contain:**
 - a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;**
 - b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:**
 - (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;**
 - (ii) Family physician; and**
 - (iii) Preferred hospital;**
 - c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;**
 - d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:**
 - (i) Allergies;**
 - (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and**
 - (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;**
 - e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;**
 - f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;**

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered that a child's file (DOE: 4/3/2019) did not have pickup information, emergency contacts, or a physician/hospital listed.
