(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files and ECE-TRIS report revealed one (1) staff member hired 8/14/17 had not received Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training PAHT. Continued review of staff files revealed four (4) staff members with hire dates of 3/15/18, 5/14/18, 7/9/18 and 7/5/18 had not completed state approved orientation training.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of Infant 2 Room revealed the wall next to the classroom sink had exposed plaster and drywall mud.

- (4) A child shall:
- (a) Be helped with personal care and cleanliness based upon his or her developmental skills;
- (b) Except as established in paragraph (c) of this subsection, wash his or her hands with liquid soap and warm running water:
- 1. a. Upon arrival at the center; or
- b. Within thirty (30) minutes of arrival for school-age children;
- 2. Before and after eating or handling food;
- 3. After toileting or diaper change;
- 4. After handling animals;
- 5. After touching an item or an area of the body soiled with body fluids or wastes; and

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to comply with hygienic practices in accordance with regulations. Observation of Infant 2 Room revealed an infant's hands were not washed after a diaper change.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain children's records in accordance with regulations. Review of ten (10) children's files revealed the written records for two (2) children enrolled 8/29/18 and 4/5/19 failed to contain contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's preferred hospital. Continued review of children's files revealed the written record for one (1) child enrolled 9/17/18 failed to be signed by the child's parent.
