Upon request, the director did not provide the statement at the time of the survey.

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. There was a hole in the ceiling tile above the wooden kitchen set and by the sprinkler in the Two's and Three's Room. There was a hole in the wall above the door in the first and second hallway bathroom exposing wires. The ceiling tile was pushed back in the second bathroom located in the hallway. There was a hole in the ceiling tile above the blue rug in the Infant Room. There was a hole in the ceiling tile above the thermostat and science area in the Four-Year-Old Room.
