Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the director did not present a current negative TB assessment or health professional's statement for staff member with hire date 7/18/17.

410 - Training

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following: (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½)

hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance to regulatory requirements. Upon request, the director did not present fifteen (15) hours of approved training, nor could the required training be verified through ECE-TRIS. Staff members with hire dates 7/18/17 and 1/3/17 are missing the required fifteen (15) hours of training.
