(3) Except in accordance with subsection (4) of this section or Section 2(2)(c) of this administrative regulation, an infant or toddler under twentyfour (24) months of age shall not participate in an activity with an older child for no more than one (1) hour per day.

(4) If a toddler is developmentally appropriate for a transition to a preschool age group, a toddler may participate in an activity with an older child for more than one (1) hour per day if:

(a) Space for the toddler is available in the preschool-age group;

(b) The staff-to-child ratios and group sizes are maintained based on the age of the youngest child;

(c) The center has a procedure for listing a transitioning toddler on attendance records, including a specific day and time the toddler is with either age group; and

(d) The child care center has obtained the signature and approval of the toddler's parent on the toddler's transition plan.

Findings:

General: Observation of the preschool room at 1:45p.m. revealed there was a nine (9) month old infant combined with older children. The infant continued to be cared for in the preschool room with the older children until 3:30p.m.

540 - Bedding/Toys in Crib

922 KAR 2:120. Section 6. Sleeping and Napping Requirements.	
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(3) Rest time shall occur in an adequate space according to the child's age as follows:

(a) For an infant:

3. No bedding other than a clean tight-fitted sheet; and

4. No toys or other items except the infant's pacifier;

Findings:

General: Observation of the preschool room revealed there was a nine (9) month old infant in a crib with a blanket. Continued observation revealed there was a plastic toy tied to the side railing of the crib that an infant was in.

565 - Inaccessible Items

(7) The following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:

(a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;

(b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and

General: Observation of the bathroom revealed five (5) bottles of Hydrogen Peroxide in a plastic container that was sitting on a low shelf where it was accessible to the children.
