- 2. Staff's (DOH: 05/01/2017) file did not contain a staff evaluation; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if a staff evaluation was completed yearly.
- 3. Staff's (DOH: 07/01/2020) file did not contain a staff evaluation; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if a staff evaluation was completed yearly.
