<b>Findings:</b>	
General: Based on interview and observation, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements associated with assuring the health, safety and comfort of all children in care. According to staff members, children attending the child care program during the school year are sleeping on the floor and are not sleeping on a two inch mat or cot in the early mornings. During the summer, the children are required to have an afternoon rest time and they are not provided with a two inch thick mat or cot and are falling asleep during rest time. Observation and interviews revealed that in the under age eight (8) classroom, there were not any sleeping mats available for the children. The children were asking staff members if they could use foam ABC puzzle pieces during rest time that were observed to not be two inches thick or manufactured for sleeping.
