(2) A child care staff member hired on or after April 1, 2018, shall:

(a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or

(b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;

2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative

regulation; and

3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the file for an employee hired on 9-17-18 contained evidence that she was fingerprinted on 9-25-18. As of the date of the survey, the results of the national background check had not yet been received. This employee was found to be working alone with four (4) one-year-old children for the duration of the survey. She also stated during interview that she has been working alone with the children from 8:30am to 4:00pm Monday thru Friday since 10-1-18. It was also found that the file for an employee hired on 6-12-18 contained evidence that she was fingerprinted on 8-2-18 and the final results were obtained on 10-2-18. During interview, this employee revealed that she had been working alone with the younger one-year-old children from 7:30am to 4:00pm Monday thru Friday since July.
