- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Two staff members hired on 8-11-17 failed to have an out of state criminal records check for the state of Florida. Both individuals had indicated on their Child Abuse and Neglect Check that they had lived outside the state of Kentucky within the past five years.

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory standards. In the toddler bathroom there was a quarter sized hole in the drywall behind the toilet paper holder.

- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. The bathroom sinks failed to be equipped with hot running water.

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. The toilet in the two's classroom failed to flush.
