Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. Based on observation, the surveyor observed an uncovered electrical outlet in the Pre-K room during the initial walk-through. A review of documentation revealed a photograph of an uncovered electrical outlet in a room where toddlers were playing.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview, and review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain equipment in accordance with regulatory requirements. Based on observation, a child was lifted out of a highchair as the surveyor entered into the room. A safety belt was not disconnected prior to the child taken from the seat. Interviews and written statements revealed that children are at times placed in the highchairs without the use of a belt.

- (11) While bottle feeding an infant, the:
- (a) Child shall be held; and
- (b) Bottle shall not be:
- 1. Propped;
- 2. Left in the mouth of a sleeping infant; or
- 3. Heated in a microwave

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulatory requirements. Interviews revealed that bottles have been propped during "busy times". Review of documentation, including photographs and written statements, revealed that bottles are propped while feeding infants in the infant room.
