General: Based on review of documentation, there was no caregiver present at the center who was certified to administer infant and child first aid and CPR. The caregivers' certification expired on 04/30/21.

- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

General: Based on review of documentation, a caregiver, hired on 09/13/19, did not complete any hours of training during a subsequent year of employment. A caregiver, hired 08/08/17, completed three and one quarter (3 1/4) training hours during a subsequent year of employment.
