Also there were seven (7) discolored and bulged ceiling tiles in the preschool room. Three (3) large holes were in the wall as a result of a water leak. Bookshelves were placed in front of the holes in the wall in the preschool room. Observation determined five (5) children played in the preschool classroom and mold was visibly present on the walls and under the sink.
