- (b) A written record for each child:
- 1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;
- 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the family child-care home; and
- 3. To contain:
- a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
- b. Contact information to enable the provider to contact the child's:
- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the family child-care home;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the provider to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence; and

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The certified provider did not have a written record for a child that was enrolled in August 2017. The child did not have a file that included identifying information about the child, contact information including, the parent's home address, place of employment, the child's family physician, and preferred hospital. There was not a written pick-up list for the child, no general health information and no authorization by the parent for the provider to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The certified provider did not have a written child care agreement on file for a child enrolled in August 2017. The certified provider did not have a list of designated individuals that could pick the child up specified by the parent.
