General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A tour of the provider's home found that the diaper changing area was positioned next to the children's playroom on the lower level of the home and the sink was in a bathroom approximately 12 to 15 feet away; therefore, the sink was not immediately adjacent to the diaper changing
