The bottom shelf of the white refrigerator used to store food was soiled with an unknown substance at the time of the survey. The white and black microwave used to prepare/heat food was soiled with old food debris.

General: Based on observation, the family child care home failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulatory requirements. The weekly menu presented for review was only completed for two days.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, the family child care home failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulatory requirements. The freezer portion of the white refrigerator had an indicating thermometer reading of eight (8) degrees Fahrenheit at the time of the survey.
