- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. One (1) staff file (hire date: 8/1/16) did not contain evidence or results of the criminal records check. The staff person in charge stated that this documentation must have been misplaced.

390 - Educational Requirements

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. One (1) staff person (hire date: 8/25/17) did not have educational documentation on file. The staff person in charge stated during interview, "This document has been ordered, but we haven't received it yet".

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of the three (3) year old classroom the surveyor observed two (2) pair of adult scissors, approximately twenty (20) push pins and a staple remover being stored in the top drawer of the teacher's desk. The drawer was unlocked; therefore, these items were accessible to the children.
