General: Based on review of documentation in order to renew their certifications, three (3) staff completed an online CPR and First Aid course provided by the American CPR Association. It is important to note that online CPR and First Aid courses are not cabinet approved and the American CPR Association is not a cabinet approved training agency. Therefore, there were no staff on duty and present with the children currently certified in CPR and First Aid training.
