General: Based on Observation, upon arrival to the facility at 10:00am a staff person was outside spraying for weeds. He walked the surveyor into the building and towards the preschool classroom. The surveyor walked into the preschool classroom and found one (1) staff person working alone with nineteen (19) children. The youngest age of child in the room was four (4) years. The surveyor also noted that a staff person left the two-year-old classroom at 11:24am-11:27am and went outside; then left again at 11:28am to go to the bathroom. This left the other two-year-old teacher alone in the classroom with eleven (11) children. At 11:30am the two-year-old classroom went outside. At 11:32am one (1) of the staff came inside to retrieve something leaving the other staff person on the playground alone with eleven (11) children.
