- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The sink located in the hall bathroom, which is used by the children, contained a water temperature of 130 degrees Fahrenheit. The Infant bathroom sink contained a water temperature of 130 degrees Fahrenheit. The staff in charge indicated that the infant room sink is currently not being used because no infants are enrolled. A sink shall have a maximum water temperature of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
