- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that two (2) staff did not complete the required fifteen hours of cabinet approved training. The hire dates for these staff are 07/16/2018 and 05/14/2015

General: Based on observation, the following was found: 1.) In the kitchen area of the preschool building, there are drawers that were not in good repair. These drawers were not able to be closed all the way and were not fully functioning. 2.) In the preschool building, there was a vent in between the classroom area and the kitchen that was not secured properly in the floor and was coming up from the floor. 3.) In the hall bathroom, there were numerous drawers that were missing the knobs to open the drawer. It should be noted that the children do not use the hall bathroom and it is only for staff.
