(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. A review of documentation, to include an ECE-TRIS report, failed to reveal 15 hours of cabinet approved child care training for a staff member with a hire date of 10/24/16. Further review failed to reveal 1 and 1/2 hours of pediatric head trauma training had been received by the staff member with a hire date of 10/24/16. Interview with the staff in charge revealed the documentation was not available for review
