Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, on 5/24/2021 the facility notified DRCC of an incident involving a staff person speaking to and handling a one-year-old child in a rough manner. The child got up from her cot and went to the table where some of the children were finishing lunch. The staff person told the child in a very loud harsh voice she was supposed to be on her cot. The staff person then picked the child up under her arms, turned around in a quick manner and sat the child down roughly on her cot. Further interviews stated this same staff person has been observed at other times speaking to the children in a harsh voice and handling them in a rough manner

It was also identified through interviews that not all staff were provided with information regarding the facility's policy regarding discipline and guidance of the children in care.
