Staff reported attempting to call the child's mother and father. Staff were unable to contact any of the child's emergency contacts as that information could not be located. The child was taken to the emergency room after being picked up by her parent during regular pick-up time.</p> <p>2) A separate incident occurred when a five-year-old child was allegedly kicked in the stomach by another preschool child leaving a red mark to the injured area.</p>

Director Requirements and Responsibilities.</p> <p>(1) A director shall:</p> <p>(l) Notify the parent immediately of an accident or incident requiring medical treatment of a child;</p> <p>Findings:</p> <p>General: Based on interview, at 4:00pm on 05/25/2021, a group of preschool children were having a dance party in their classroom when a five-year-old child was pushed down by another child, causing the child to fall into the edge of a sensory table. The five-year-old child received a cut behind her ear. The child was brought to the front office, first aid was administered and a phone call to both mother and father of the child was attempted. A voice mail was left with the father but according to staff, a message could not be left for the mother. Staff stated that the cut would stop bleeding for a while and then start back up. The staff stated that it could not be determined if the child needed medical attention due to the child's hair being in the way of the cut. The child's emergency contact numbers were not utilized on the day of the incident because the binder with the emergency phone numbers could not be located. Staff stated that the mother of the five-year-old child arrived at normal pick up time (approximately 5:00pm) and was told by staff that her child had a head injury. The child was then taken to the emergency room where glue was used to close the cut.</p>
