General: Based on review of documentation, staff hired on 07/07/2021, and 10/18/2021, did not have documentation on file from a health care professional stating they were free of active tuberculosis.

435 - Training

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;

General: Based on observation, the kitchen door was propped open during part of the inspection. The surveyor found a knife sitting out on the counter, a ClickSan Disinfectant solution was found in an unlocked cabinet. In addition, the oven and a stove top burner were on and hot to the touch. All of these areas were accessible to the children.

- (d) Use hand sanitizer or hand-sanitizing wipes if liquid soap and warm running water are not available in accordance with paragraph (c) of this subsection. The staff shall wash the staff's hands as soon as practicable once liquid soap and warm running water are available.
