922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following: (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE - TRIS, the surveyor found the following:

(1.) Staff (DOH: 9/15/17) did not obtain the six (6) hours of cabinet - approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment. The owner stated the staff obtained orientation training years ago. Documentation was not provided during the surveyor's visit.

(2.) Staff (DOH: 9/15/17) needs to obtain the one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training.

(3.) Staff (DOH: 9/15/17) obtained six (6) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet - approved early care and education training.

(4.) Staff (DOH: 9/15/17) obtained nine (9) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet - approved early care and education training.

(5.) Staff (DOH: 11/27/17) obtained thirteen and one-half (13 1/2) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet – approved early care and education training.

(6.) Staff (DOH: 9/25/17) obtained thirteen and one-half (13 ½) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet – approved early care and education training.

(7.) Staff (DOH: 9/15/17) obtained the one and one-half hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training on 11/1/18; therefore, the training was not obtained during the staff's first year of employment.

(1) An infant shall sleep or nap on the infant's back unless the infant's health professional signs a waiver that states the infant requires an alternate sleeping position.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the surveyor found two (2) infants sleeping in bouncy seats. The owner reported the infants have acid reflux requiring them to sleep in an elevated position. The children do not have a waiver from a health professional stating that they require an alternate sleeping position.

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the surveyor found that a child's (DOE: 8/15/17) file did not contain information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's preferred physician. The owner reported that she would have the child's parents update the information in the file.
