(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain staff files in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the director did not present fifteen (15) hours of approved training for staff members with the hire dates 9/11/17 and 10/13/17.

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements in regards to inaccessible items. Observation in the school age area revealed a can of Glade fragrance spray with a label "Keep Out of Reach of Children" on a shelf within reach of children.
