General: Based on Review of Documentation, there were two (2) staff persons who had not completed the required six (6) hours of orientation training within the 90 day time frame from their date of hire. Additionally, another staff with a hire date of 5/11/15 had not completed the required fifteen (15) hours of annual training within their past year of employment. This information was confirmed through the ECE Tris system as well.
