220 - Reports to Cabinet Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 13. Reports.

- (1) The following shall be reported to the cabinet or designee and other agencies specified in this section within twenty-four (24) hours from the time of discovery:
- (a) Communicable disease, which shall also be reported to the local health department pursuant to KRS 214.010;
- (b) An accident or injury to a child that requires medical care initiated by the child-care center or the child's parent;
- (c) An incident that results in legal action by or against the child-care center that:
- 1. Affects a child or staff person; or
- 2. Includes the center's discontinuation or disqualification from a governmental assistance program due to fraud, abuse, or criminal conviction related to that program:
- (d) An incident involving fire or other emergency, including a vehicular accident when the center is transporting a child receiving child care services;
- (e) A report of child abuse or neglect that:
- 1. Has been accepted by the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 1:330; and
- 2. Names a director, employee, volunteer, or person with supervisory or disciplinary control over, or having unsupervised contact with, a child in care as the alleged perpetrator; or
- (f) An individual specified in Section 6(4) of this administrative regulation meeting a disqualifying criterion or background check result pursuant to 922 KAR 2:280.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the center failed to report to the cabinet within twenty-four (24) hours from the time of discovery an injury to a child that required medical attention. A two-year-old child was pushed by another student and fell at approximately 10:20am on 4/11/22. The child left the center at 1:52pm on 4/11/22 to ask what happened to the child's left arm while the child was at the center. The child was taken to the ER at Medical Center of Bowling Green and diagnosed to have a forearm fracture. The parent went to the center at approximately 9:00am on 4/12/22 and told the director that the child received medical treatment on 4/11/22 but the center did not report to the cabinet representative.



225 - Licensee Responsibility Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General.

- (1) A licensee shall:
- (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the center failed to provide for the comfort of a two-year-old child who was pushed by another child and fell as the children returned inside the building after outdoor play time at approximately 10:20am on 4/11/22. The child cried and the caregiver checked the child's legs but found no injury. Interviews indicated the child did not break the fall with her hands or arm when the child fell. During the lunch meal at approximately 11:10am on 4/11/22, the child cried and would not feed herself; therefore, a staff member fed the child. Another staff member noticed the child held her left wrist and after examination, did not notice an injury. The staff member held the child in her lap until the child fell asleep. The child's parent picked up the child at 1:52pm on 4/11/22. The parent called the center at 2:13pm on 4/11/22 to ask what happened to the child's left arm. The child's parent took the child to the ER on 4/11/22 and was told the child had a forearm fracture. The child's left arm was placed in a cast on 4/12/22.
